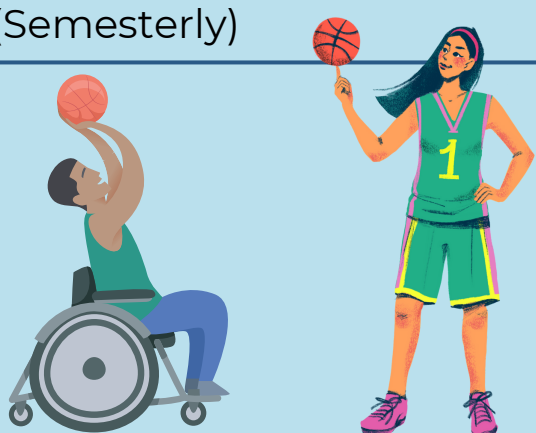


### PROJECT UNIFY CLUB

Volunteer in an ILC classroom to help develop social skills, build relationships and be a positive role model. You may be able to earn an elective credit. (Semesterly)

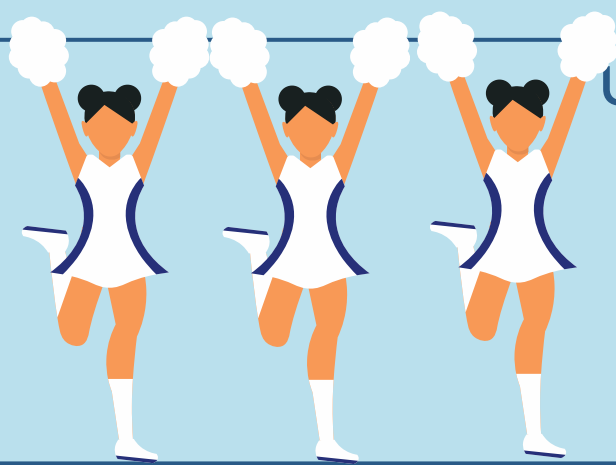
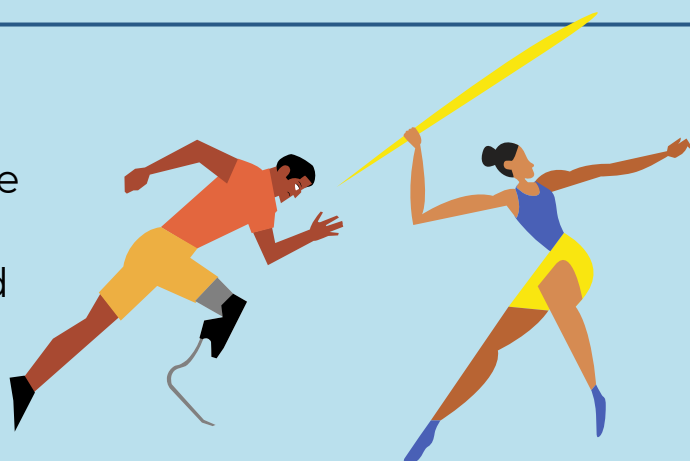


### UNIFIED BASKETBALL
